

POTATO PARTY

Have the Host ask everyone invited to bring a potato of any kind to the party.

Award points for the following:

For a washed potato: 25 For each eye on the potato: 20

For a dirty potato: 100

For the largest: 100 For the smallest: 25

For a red potato: 150 For a white potato: 75

For a sweet potato: 250 For a rotten potato: 350

For a baked potato: 200

If you brought it in Tupperware: 300

Give a game prize to the one with the most points; then, bake your potatoes in 3-qt. Casserole, with cone, in Stack Cooker OR in VNS Large Deep.

Serve with favorite toppings (served in Serving Center Set).



Let's have a Banana Split Party!

When planning the party, ask the host to tell everyone to bring a banana to the party. She may want to buy a couple extras to have on hand in case someone forgets.

At the beginning of the party—have everyone go around the room & introduce. Tell them: using the first letter of your name, describe your banana in one word and introduce yourself. Example - My name is Stephanie and my banana is Scrumptious.

Point game: Highest score wins.

Smallest 20

Thinking about having party 50

Sticker on it 25

All Yellow 35

Any brown spots 10

Thinking about making \$ TW 50

Want to eat it with ice cream 25



Have banana splits for refreshments after the party!

HOW OBSERVANT ARE YOU

This game is to see how observant the guests are about their hostess!

Just to confuse guests: Have the hostess carry around the room a tray with several small household items on it, and have the guests look over everything on the tray. (This is to distract guests from the real purpose of the game). Then have the Hostess go in another room, and ask the following:

1. What is the color of her hair?

2. What color pants is she wearing?

3. What is the color of her eyes?

4. Describe her shoes/Is she wearing flats shoes or heels?

5. Is she wearing a necklace?

6. Describe her shirt/top.

7. Is she wearing glasses?

8. How tall is she (within 1 inch)?

9. Is she wearing earrings?

10. Is she wearing a bracelet or watch?

11. How many rings is she wearing?

12. Does she have on makeup? What?

13. Is she wearing nail polish?

Whoever has the most points wins!!

HAWAIIAN GAME

DID YOU KNOW—we have the opportunity in Tupperware to earn a free trip for two to Hawaii! It's true! (My friend has been TWICE!)

This is a fun game to relax everybody. Give each person a piece of paper. Tell them to lay in on the catalog and turn lengthwise on their laps. Tell them to close their eyes and keep them closed for the entire game.

We're going on a Hawaiian vacation, so draw an island in the middle of your paper.

---to the left of your island, draw a ship

---you are surrounded by water, so put some fish in the sea

---this is Hawaii, so put a palm tree on the island

---its a nice day, so put some birds in the air

---that ship didn't get there all by itself, so put a sailor on the ship

---he might get hungry, so draw some coconuts on the palm tree

---sailors like to see where they are going, so put some port holes on the ship

---sailors like entertainment, so draw a hula dancer on the island

---it's a sunny day, so put a sun in the sky



Score points if:

Your island is in the middle 10 points

Your ship is to the left of the island, but not touching 10 points

For each fish you have 5 points

For the base of the palm tree being on the island 5 points

For each bird you drew 5 points

If the sailor is on the ship, not swimming 15 points

If any coconut is on the tree 5 points

If the porthole is on the ship 10 points

If the hula dancer is on the island 15 points

Now the sun: If to the left 20 points If to the right 15 points If in the middle 10 points

EASTER IN THE PARK

Imagine your paper is a park in the spring time, and follow my directions (with eyes CLOSED).

1. Draw a pond in the middle of your park.
2. Draw a sailboat on your pond.
3. The sun is shining high in the sky.
4. There is a big tree on the right side of the park.
5. There is an Easter basket under the tree.
6. There are eggs in the basket.
7. There are birds flying over the water.
8. One of the eggs hatched. Draw a baby chick by the basket
9. There are kids playing ball in the park.
10. Write the date that Easter falls on this year.
11. There are two people in the sailboat.

Give yourself points based on the following:

1. 5 points if your sailboat has more than 1 sail.
2. 10 points if your sun has rays.
3. 5 points if you drew a ball for the kids to play with.
4. 1 points for every egg that is touching the basket.
5. 5 points if your chick is on the ground and not in the tree.
6. 5 points if you knew that Easter was on _____ this year.
7. 1 point for every bird in the sky.
8. 10 points if your kids have faces and aren't just circles.
9. 5 points (each) if your people are IN the boat.



WARM UP/ICE BREAKER GAME or maybe call Follow the Directions Game!

Write the following list on a piece of paper, but have each sheet have the items listed in various orders (in other words Shake hands with 5 people might be #1 on one list; #3 on another; #5 on another) - - BUT BE SURE that all lists have #9 listed as #9 on each list. Pass a list to each guest, and tell her to do each action on her list in the order in which it is listed.

1. Shake hands with 5 people
2. Scream "I LOVE TUPPERWARE!" out the front door
3. Say your name loudly
4. Look out the back door
5. Make a face in the mirror
6. Introduce yourself to the Demonstrator
7. Flap your wings like a bird
8. Take off your right shoe and leave it in the center of the room

****9** THIS IS NUMBER 9 on each list**

9. Go to the display, choose a product, and take it back to your seat with you.

After all have chosen their item and are seated, have a guest go to center of the room, put her shoe back on her foot, tell the other guests why she chose the item she has, and demonstrate it. Each guest receives a prize.

Shape-O Toy Relay

Divide entire party into two teams (host does or doesn't play—whatever makes it even). Each guest dumps shapes onto table/floor, puts all back into ball, next person goes. First team finished wins.

Tupper Robber

You'll need a deck of cards & prizes to put in the middle of the floor. (I normally use a few more than how many people there are.)

Seat guests in a circle. Go around the circle QUICKLY & when you get to each guest, they say "red" or "black". You flip up a card. If it matches what they say, you say "pick a prize". If they say color correctly & it is a face card, you say "yes! take two!". If the color does not match, you say "sorry" or "oh no, too bad" or some other funny "you-didn't-win" line....

Once all prizes are gone from the floor—they steal from each other. You're finished when you get through the entire deck.

Take the gift and look around.
